


Labelling Physician Office Collected Specimens

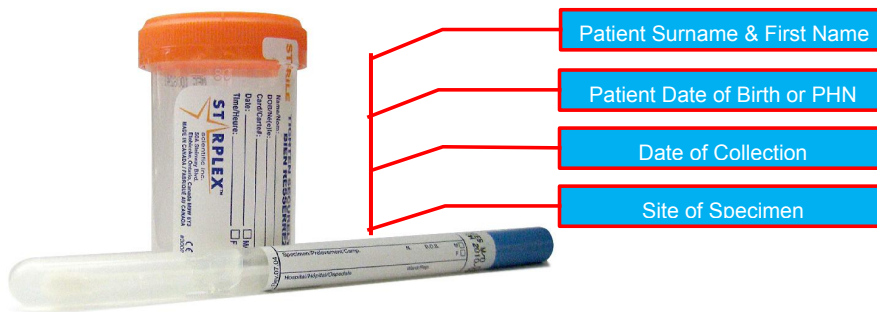

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Free Report Copies for Patients - Only through *my ehealth*

For many years, BC Biomedical Laboratories has been providing hard copy reports to patients who have requested them, free of charge. We are currently mailing over 10,000 reports per month to patients. As this number continues to grow, this is no longer sustainable from a logistics and financial perspective.



BC Biomedical Laboratories and LifeLabs Medical Services have begun informing patients that in early 2011, we will begin charging for hard copy reports on a cost-recovery basis (\$10 for each request; \$25 per annum for unlimited reports for standing order patients).

We hope that most patients will elect to subscribe to *my ehealth* instead of receiving hard copy reports in that *my ehealth*:

- is a free service
- provides instant access to results as they become available by the testing laboratory and is available in four languages
- allows patients to access current and historical results (dating back until the time of initial registration)
- is highly secure
